Our vision is to create a world-class environment for learning, where all members of our community are able to thrive. Every day, our team of incredibly dedicated and skilled staff work hard to achieve this vision. We do this by focusing on three key areas: learning & achievement; careers & life skills; and mental health & well-being.

It has been recognised by Ofsted that we provide **outstanding** Personal Development for our students, by providing “an exceptional range of well-planned extra-curricular clubs, trips and residential visits”. We believe that these things are important because they help us develop the whole child, but also provide precious life-long memories for our students.

Our inspirational leaders have designed an ambitious curriculum for pupils, which covers a broad range of subjects, academic qualifications and vocational pathways. We have strong links with local businesses and organisations, which means we can bring learning to life by taking students to see how these subjects fit into the real world. As a result, students make excellent progress.

Our expert team of staff teach lessons that are exciting and make best use of evidence and research, but that are also safe, calm and orderly. We believe that high quality relationships with students and parents are fundamental to getting the best out of children and this approach means that the whole school is a caring, friendly and supportive place to be.

When things become difficult ‘The Hub’ provides outstanding pastoral care, and “provides a haven for the most disadvantaged students”. In recognition of this, and other areas of work, we have received the Gold Award from the Carnegie Centre of Excellence for Mental Health in Schools. This is a highly prestigious accolade, which very few schools have achieved.

We have very high standards regarding attendance, behaviour, uniform and attitude to learning. However, in return, we are world-class in our celebration of student achievement. This ranges from certificates and badges, up to magnificent awards evenings at Holkham Hall with celebrity guest speakers and amazing performances from our talented students.

Being a member of the APHS community means being part of an extraordinary journey where we learn to make the difference, as well as living and breathing the values of Ambition, Pride, Happiness and Success. We would love for you to join us on that journey.

The Trust is committed to investing in Alderman Peel High School and its education and has spent £700,000 on new roofs, window and boiler upgrades since the school joined. We are also funding two additional new classrooms in summer 2022.

The Wensum Trust also offers experiences that allow children to explore their interests and talents from an early age with our unique partnerships with businesses and organisations such as Wells Sea Cadets, North Walsham Rugby Football Club, Norwich Theatre, Norwich City Community Sports Foundation, Lovell and the Zoological Society of East Anglia.

By providing each child with a clear career trajectory, we lift their aspirations and give them a sense of belonging, whilst paving the way for life-long learning and positive relationships.

WE NURTURE & UNLEASH STUDENT POTENTIAL

ADMISSIONS & TRANSITIONS

We recognise that starting high school is a big step and we do all we can to aid the transition process. This goal is achieved by:

- WE visit each and every Year 6 in their primary school prior to their Transition Days at Alderman Peel High School
- WE offer additional bespoke Transition Days to all students with Special Educational Needs, students who may be anxious about high school and students lacking in confidence.
- WE offer every Year 6 student THREE Transition Days – with a key message of “Aiming High, Working Hard” to unleash their FULL Potential.
- WE have a Transition Evening for parents/carers to carefully explain how they can work with the school to ensure their child’s full potential is unleashed. Also, to share in our school’s ethos and values.
- WE provide every parent/carer with a Year 7 handbook. This provides parents/carers with clear access on how to support their child in high school e.g. who to contact for different purposes, guidance on attendance and homework.
- WE offer every parent/carer access to their child’s daily positive/negative feedback from subject staff via our online Parent App. This allows parent/carers to take an active role in their child’s education.
- WE ensure any new student starting APHS has a tour of the school with their parent/carer during the school day. The parent/carer and student also meet with the Assistant Principal to go through school expectations.

Our excellent Transition Programme ensures our students arrive at APHS in September confident, with high ambitions, adopting a fantastic Attitude to Learning (AtL) and ready to learn!

STUDENT VOICE & LEADERSHIP

OFFERING A WIDE RANGE OF OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENT LEADERSHIP IS A KEY PRIORITY AT ALDERMAN PEEL HIGH SCHOOL

We believe strongly that the benefits of student leadership are wide and varied. Leadership is encouraged from the start of Year 7, with opportunities to contribute to whole school decision-making through School Parliament and Eco Council Committees.

For students in Year 7 and above, a strong student Ambassador programme runs in many subject areas, with students leading peers, primary pupils and clubs. In Year 10, the majority of students aspire to being successful in the rigorous process of the selection of Head Boy, Head Girl and Prefects. An elected team led by the Head Boy and Girl is hugely influential in the life and ethos of the school, both day-to-day and at all public events. Students are regularly complimented on their exemplary behaviour, team working, communication skills and confidence when representing our school within and beyond our local community.

We are exceptionally proud of all their achievements.

Our leadership possibilities mean that students act as role models for their peers; make a positive contribution to the school and the wider community; develop the skills and attitudes to enable them to participate positively in society; are able to express their views and ideas about the school; and contribute to decisions about their learning.

WE PROVIDE OUR STUDENTS WITH A FANTASTIC CURRICULUM

AT ALDERMAN PEEL HIGH SCHOOL, WE STRIVE TO NURTURE AND DEVELOP SUCCESSFUL LEARNERS FOR THE FUTURE, EQUIPPED WITH THE SKILLS THAT WILL ENABLE THEM TO PROSPER AND ACHIEVE IN THE 21ST CENTURY.

We therefore embrace a curriculum that is broad, well balanced and flexible enough to meet the needs of each individual student. All students are encouraged and supported to achieve their full potential and to celebrate their successes. We firmly believe that by making learning challenging, innovative and engaging we help our students acquire the skills to become resilient, resourceful and reflective learners, both within and beyond the classroom.

KEY STAGE 3 (AGES 11-13) YEARS 7-9

During the first three years, students build on their successful work at primary school to develop the knowledge, skills and understanding which form the foundation for future study at Key Stage 4 and beyond.

Our Key Stage 3 Curriculum includes the following subjects: English, Mathematics, Science, French, Spanish, Geography, History, Religious Education, Art, Design and Design Technology, Music, Drama, Physical Education, Computing, Self & Society and Citizenship Education.

KEY STAGE 4 (AGES 14-16) YEARS 10-11

At Key Stage 4, all students follow a core curriculum, in line with the National Curriculum, which includes English Language, English Literature, Maths, Science (Double or Triple), core PE and Self & Society. In addition to the core subjects, students are given the opportunity to select a variety of other GCSE or equivalent subjects to meet their needs. The range of subjects students can choose from within is extensive and diverse, ensuring that students have a broad range of qualifications upon completion.

THE 'MOST ABLE, GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENTS (MAGT)'

Identifying the gifted and talented continues to be a voyage of discovery. Some students will already have been identified as 'gifted and talented' at their primary schools, but others will emerge later in response to the challenging opportunities offered in secondary school. At Alderman Peel High School we are committed to helping students uncover their strengths, as well as providing for those that are already obvious.

The school pays for MAGT students to take part in the Brilliant Club (www.thebrilliantclub.org). MAGT students are required to undertake weekly reading and writing assignments that lead to the completion of an extended assignment that the PhD tutors then marks and grades thoroughly.

Most Able, Gifted and Talented students are nurtured by an appointed MAGT Co-ordinator dedicated to ensuring that their personal learning needs are met.

SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

At Alderman Peel High School, everybody cares. In our school community, caring about the needs of the individual is essential to ensure happiness and success.

The Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator (SENCO) and a team of highly qualified Teaching Assistants ensure that students with Special Educational Needs are supported and make rapid progress at Alderman Peel High School.

WE PROVIDE AMAZING OPPORTUNITIES

EXTRA-CURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES

We compete at a high level in all sports and students also have the opportunity to represent their House in a variety of sports. The school has been awarded Norfolk Sports School of the Year. Some of the more unique sports include: Sailing, Equestrian, Skiing and Beach Volley-ball (to mention a few)

The school is renowned for its musical and dramatic talents and alongside the concerts, orchestral and vocal groups. The school annually presents a major musical production and drama productions with huge numbers of students participating in each event. In 2021/2022 we were awarded the School Music Hub of the Year.

We currently offer 86 FREE lunchtime and after-school clubs per week.

We offer a huge variety of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) activities and clubs: including Robotics Club, Coding Club, KS3 STEM Club and KS4 STEM Club.

Many departments offer trips to enrich the study of their subject and some of these have included French/Spanish trips to different regions of France and Spain, Geographers carrying-out field-work on the North Norfolk coast and North Wales, Sailing competitions in the USA, Music Performances and a skiing trips to Italy/France.
